

## Prescribing Information

### **Oilatum® Junior and Oilatum® Emollient (light liquid paraffin 63.4%)** Bath Additive.

**Indications** Contact dermatitis, atopic dermatitis, senile pruritus, ichthyosis and related dry skin conditions. **Dosage and administration** All ages: Apply to wet skin or add to water. *Adult bath:* 1-3 capfuls in an 8 inch bath of water, soak for 10-20 minutes, pat dry. *Infant bath:* ½-2 capfuls in a basin of water, apply gently over entire body with a sponge, pat dry. Emollient only: *Skin cleansing:* Rub a small amount of oil into wet skin, rinse, pat dry. **Precautions** Hypersensitivity to any ingredient. Stop use if rash or irritation develops. **Side effects** See SPC for full details. Application site reactions including erythema, rash, pruritus, dermatitis. **Legal category** GSL. **Presentation and NHS cost** Junior: 150 ml £2.82, 250 ml £3.25, 300 ml £5.10 and 600 ml £5.89. ### **Oilatum® Cream and Oilatum® Junior Cream (light liquid paraffin 6%, white soft paraffin 15%)**

**Indications** Contact dermatitis, atopic eczema, senile pruritus, ichthyosis and related dry skin conditions. **Dosage and administration** All ages: Use as often as required. Rub in well to affected area. **Contraindications and Precautions** Hypersensitivity to any ingredient. **Side effects** See SPC for full details. Application site reactions including erythema, rash, pain, pruritus, burning, dermatitis. **Legal category** GSL. **Presentation and NHS cost** Junior Cream *Tube:* 150 g £3.38, *Pump:* 350 ml £4.65, 500 ml £4.99, 1050 ml £9.98. ### **Oilatum® Shower Gel Fragrance-Free and Oilatum Gel (light liquid paraffin 70%)**

**Indications** Contact dermatitis, atopic dermatitis, senile pruritus, ichthyosis and related dry skin conditions. **Dosage and administration** All ages: Apply to wet skin, normally as a shower gel. Use as frequently as necessary. **Precautions** Hypersensitivity to any ingredient. Not for use on greasy skin. **Side effects** Application site reactions including erythema, rash, pruritus, dermatitis. **Legal category** GSL. **Presentation and NHS cost** 150 g £5.15. ### **Oilatum® Plus (light liquid paraffin 52.5%, benzalkonium chloride 6%, triclosan 2%)**

**Indications** Bath additive for prophylactic treatment of eczemas at risk from infection. **Dosage and administration** Always dilute with water. Do not use with soap. Use once daily. *Adults and children:* 1 capful in a 4 inch bath or 2 capfuls in an eight inch bath. *Infants over 6 months:* Add 1 ml to infant bath. Soak for 10-15 minutes and gently pat skin dry. Do not use for babies younger than 6 months. **Contraindications** Hypersensitivity to any ingredient. **Precautions** Discontinue use if rash or irritation occurs. Undiluted product may cause irritation and hypersensitivity reactions including skin exfoliation, pain, blister, caustic injury and necrosis. **Side effects** See SPC for full details; exfoliation, erythema, dermatitis, pruritus, burning sensation and application site hypersensitivity. **Legal category** GSL. **Presentation and NHS cost** 500 ml £6.98.
